

LR Independent Assurance Statement

Relating to Nabtesco Group's environmental and social data for the calendar year 2019

This Assurance Statement has been prepared for Nabtesco Corporation in accordance with our contract but is intended for the readers of this report.

Terms of engagement

Lloyd's Register Quality Assurance ("LR") was commissioned by Nabtesco Corporation to provide independent assurance on Nabtesco Group's ("the Company") environmental and social data within the CSR Page as published on its corporate website ("the report") for the calendar year 2019, that is, 1 January to 31 December 2019, against the assurance criteria below to a limited level of assurance using ISAE3000 and ISO 14064-3:2006 for greenhouse gas ("GHG") emissions data.

Our assurance engagement covered the operations and activities relating te Company and its consolidated subsidiaries in Japan and overseas and specifically the following requirements: 1

- Verifying conformance with the Company's reporting methodologies for the selected dataset:
- Evaluating the accuracy and reliability of data for the selected indicators listed below:
 - o Energy consumption
 - o GHG emissions data (Scope 1, Scope 2 [Market-based] and Scope3) 2 3 4
 - o Water consumption and water discharge
 - o Waste generated and landfilled, and hazardous waste generated
 - o Chemical substances controlled under the PRTR scheme and VOC emissions
 - o Percentage of the Company's main suppliers with GHG emission reduction targets, and
 - o Occupational accident rate 5
 - o Occupational disease rate ⁶

Our assurance engagement excluded the data and information of the Company's contractors and any third-parties mentioned in the report.

LR's responsibility is only to the Company. LR disclaims any liability or responsibility to others as explained in the end footnote. The Company's responsibility is for collecting, aggregating, analysing and presenting all the data and information within the report and for maintaining effective internal controls over the systems from which the report is derived. Ultimately, the report has been approved by, and remains the responsibility of the Company.

LR's Opinion

Based on LR's approach nothing has come to our attention that would cause us to believe the Company has not, in all material respects:

- Met the requirements above
- Disclosed accurate and reliable environmental and social data

The opinion expressed is formed on the bases of a limited level of assurance and at the materiality of the professional judgement of the verifier.

¹ Energy consumption, GHG emissions (Scope1 and Scope 2), and water consumption data only included Nabtesco Corporation and Nabtesco Group's consolidated subsidiaries in Japan and overseas. However, the other indirect GHG emissions data (Scope3) and -Percentage of NABTESCO's main suppliers with GHG emission reduction targets only included the domestic operations of Nabtesco Corporation. And other selected datasets listed above only included the Nabtesco Corporation and Nabtesco Group consolidated subsidiaries in Japan.

² GHG quantification is subject to inherent uncertainty.

 $^{^3}$ Scope 1 GHG emissions cover energy oriented CO $_2$ emissions.

⁴ Scope 1 GHG emissions don't cover CO₂ emitted by own or leased business car use.

Note: The extent of evidence-gathering for a limited assurance engagement is less than for a reasonable assurance engagement. Limited assurance engagements focus on aggregated data rather than physically checking source data at sites. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

LR's approach

LR's assurance engagements are carried out in accordance with ISO14064-3 and ISAE3000. The following tasks though were undertaken as part of the evidence gathering process for this assurance engagement:

- Auditing the Company's data management systems to confirm that there were no significant errors, omissions
 or mis-statements in the report. We did this by reviewing the effectiveness of data handling procedures,
 instructions and systems, including those for internal verification.
- Interviewing with those key people responsible for compiling the data and drafting the report.
- Sampling datasets and traced activity data back to aggregated levels;
- Verifying the CY2019 data and records associated with Environmental and Social data; and
- Visiting Tsu Plant of Nabtesco Corporation to confirm the data collection processes, record management practices, and to physically check its fuel oil tanks, water meters and waste drop-off station etc.
- By implementing a "No Visitor" Policy due to the global infection spread of COVID-19, conducting the remote verification to Kobe Plant of Nabtesco Corporation and Nabtesco Corporation's headquarter for confirming the effectiveness of its data management system via emails, telephone, and Webex.

Observations

The Company should continue improving the reporting and control systems to further demonstrate the effective management of the environmental and social data.

LR's standards, competence and independence

LR implements and maintains a comprehensive management system that meets accreditation requirements for ISO 14065 Greenhouse gases – Requirements for greenhouse gas validation and verification bodies for use in accreditation or other forms of recognition and ISO/IEC 17021-1 Conformity assessment – Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems – Part 1: Requirements that are at least as demanding as the requirements of the International Standard on Quality Control 1 and comply with the Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants issued by the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants.

LR ensures the selection of appropriately qualified individuals based on their qualifications, training and experience. The outcome of all verification and certification assessments is then internally reviewed by senior management to ensure that the approach applied is rigorous and transparent.

LR is the Company's certification body for ISO 9001, ISO 14001, OHSAS 18001, IATF16949 and IRIS. The verification and certification assessments are the only work undertaken by LR for the Company and as such does not compromise our independence or impartiality.
