

Nabtesco Awarded 2013 Boeing Supplier of the Year Award

Nabtesco Corporation (headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President & CEO: Kazuaki Kotani) has been given the prestigious honor of being selected as 2013 Supplier of the Year by Boeing Commercial Airplanes (Boeing, headquarters: Chicago, Illinois; Chairman and Chief Executive Officer: W. James McNerney, Jr.). Nabtesco (formerly Teijin Seiki) was last honored with this award in 1995 after winning the 777 Flight Control Actuation System (FCAS) contract.

Boeing honors only 16 organizations with its Supplier of the Year Awards from more than 21,000 suppliers and partners around the world.
