Nabtesco becomes the first Japanese global supplier of entrance systems for railroad vehicles of Bombardier

Nabtesco Corporation (headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President & CEO: Kazuaki Kotani) has been approved by Bombardier Transportation as the first Japanese global supplier of entrance systems for railroad vehicles.

This global supplier approval represents qualification to receive official request for offer from railroad business sector of Bombardier Transportation over 16 countries and 21 locations. This will largely contribute to the expansion of door system business of both Nabtesco and our Italian subsidiary Nabtesco Oclap S.r.l.

The first project will be the Cross Rail with total network of 118.5km, which is being built at the southeast part of the United Kingdom. Nabtesco Oclap S.r.l. passed the audit by Bombardier Transportation in the aspects of production, quality, financial and management and received official order from Bombardier Transportation UK with Cab Doors (260 sets) for 65 9-car Aventra trains which will be manufactured and assembled at Bombardier's plant in Derby. This new line to be opened by 2018 will connect east and west of London and also connect to Heathrow Airport.

With this order, the number of our door product for railroad vehicles being used in the United Kingdom will rise over 4,000 and we will spare no effort to further expand our business throughout Europe.
